Supervised student clinic is a core requisite for the completion of the Certificate IV and Diploma level professional training courses. Supervision by Jenny Nicholson or Andrea Flynn will give you the opportunity to meet the required competencies involved in Clinic and the confidence to use your skills and work in a simulated natural therapies environment with real clients from the public.



At each clinic you will treat 3 clients with varying problems. Jenny Nicholson will co-ordinate the clinics and accept bookings. This year you will be required to begin your clinic hours at the completion of Aromatherapy 2, at the mid point of Remedial Massage, and take part in the shorter clinics for Kahuna and Pacific Island Massage, Lomi Lomi, Sacred Heated Stone Therapy, Lymphatic Drainage and Reflexology (Diploma level) You will need your senior first aid certificate prior to beginning clinics and have a copy on file in the office.

We also enjoy working with the wider community such as the Relay for Life and other events, where you will be able to get some of your required clinic hours up and also help a worthwhile cause!

Equipment - You are required to bring your own towels (3 clean matching towels **per client**), antiseptic wipes, handtowels, massage oil, exercise book to record client details, at least 10 essential oils if you are an Aromatherapy student, lunch or a light tea, and other equipment you may need. Dress - You are **required** to wear neat black pants, neat closed in shoes (NOT joggers) and a neat black shirt. Hair is to be neat and tidy and a minimum of jewellery.

You must confirm your attendance at each clinic by notifying Megan the **Thursday** prior to each Sunday clinic. Failure to attend a booked clinic will be seriously viewed and the loss to the college recouped. There **will not be exceptions** to this as disappointing clients and being unreliable is contrary to some of the compliances within the Clinic framework. You may book 2 clinics ahead.
