

# Diploma of Aromatherapy (ATMS)



**Flexible program to be studied full time or part time**

Pre-requisite is Certificate IV in Aromatherapy - 360 hours plus Senior First Aid Certificate –Evening classes beginning 21/04/10



**The Diploma of Aromatherapy** adds to all the skills and knowledge you gained in completing the Certificate IV in Aromatherapy. Please Note: The core modules are the same for all the Diploma level qualifications and include Nutrition to comply with hours required for Diploma level.

**Pathophysiology** - You will learn the special language skills you need to be able to confer with other health professionals, write accurate reports and referrals, develop an understanding of the way medical terms are “put together” and learn the common abbreviations used by mainstream health professionals use in liaising with each other and with you. Your text book will be an invaluable reference tool. This module also deals with the basic pathological or disease processes of the body, the methodology of history taking, physical examination and a study of a range of the diseases in each of the body systems. Gain an amazing insight into the complexities of our bodies!!

**Supervised Clinic** - 50 extra hours Clinic are required to be completed to comply with requirements by industry standards and for Health Fund provider numbers. Please refer to the clinic sheet for timetable and supervisor's contact number

**Lymphatic Drainage** - You will have the opportunity to learn the basic principles and techniques on how to give a lymphatic drainage massage. The lymphatic system is closely associated with the body's immune system and can therefore affect our levels of health and wellbeing in a major way. **Being able to give a good lymphatic drainage massage is becoming a highly sought after skill, often recommended by naturopaths and other health professionals as an adjunct to a detoxification program.** It is also highly recommended both pre and post operative, or for people suffering the after effects of cancer. Mention cellulite, lymphatic drainage and detoxifying essential oils together, and your business will be of great interest to a lot of people!! It will be offered over 16 weeks in 2010. Nature Care teacher Vikki Cole will be your teacher.
